

FROM THE TENTH AMENDMENT COALITION OF FLORIDA

Instructions for obtaining and mailing a 10th Amendment Resolution Petition to your Florida State Representative. Even you have no experience with this, you can use these instructions and the Live links below to find the name and contact information (mailing addresses and telephone numbers) of your Representative.

The 1 page Tenth Amendment Petition for Florida's State Sovereignty can be downloaded by clicking **Sign The Petition!** in the Tenth Amendment section of the Speak Out Florida website-

After printing the single page, fill out and sign the petition statement at the bottom and send it to your State Representative, whose mailing addresses and phone numbers (Capitol and district offices) can be found by one of the following methods (A, B, or C):

A) If you know who your Representative is, click the MyFloridaHouse.gov link at <http://BillofRightsDay.org/>. You will then see a page on which all members of the House of Representatives are listed alphabetically., **click on your Rep's name in the column headed by the word "Representative" to bring up the their web page, on which you will find contact information in the left hand margin**, plus helpful biographical information **and** a list of the committees on which the legislator serves.

B) If you don't know the name of your Representative, but do know (from your voter registration card) the "State House" DISTRICT in which you live, you can click the word "**District**" at the top of the third column (at MyFloridaHouse.gov) to sort the list by district number, and then scroll down the column till you find your district number, and then click on your legislator's name in the first column to bring up your legislator's information page.

C) If you know neither the name of your Representative nor the district number in which you live, you can find your legislator's information page by first clicking on the link in the line that says "Find your Representative at myfloridahouse.gov" at <http://BillofRightsDay.org/>. That will take you to a page where, in the left hand margin, toward the bottom you can find a box that is titled "**Find Your Representative**". There, **enter your 9 digit zip code, and then click on "GO"**, which will take you to the web page of **your Representative**. **If you don't know your full 9 digit zip code, click on [What's my Zip+4](#)**, then enter your address and click on "submit" to get it.
